



Sif adding 140 kton monopile foundations related volume to 2026 orderbook

Roermond, 3 September 2024. Sif Holding announces that the company has engaged in exclusive negotiations for a 140 kilotonnes monopile related foundations project. This volume relates to a project that is part of the CfD 6 auction outcome published earlier today. It is expected that a final contract will be reached before the end of 2024. At that moment more information can be shared on the content of the project.

Execution of the works is foreseen for 2026. This will increase Sif's orderbook for 2026 to 210 kilotonnes.
